RE: Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Park Amenities

Block House Municipal Utility District Residents:

The Block House MUD Board of Directors (“Board of Directors”) are committed to doing everything we can to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our residents. We want to keep you informed about the District’s response to the presence of the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19 that is posing a challenge to the way we operate as a District and as individuals. The speed at which change is occurring means we must also be flexible and ready to adapt to new changes.

On March 18, 2020 Williamson County Judge Bill Gravell issued a second mass gathering order that prohibits social community gatherings of 10 people or more through May 11, 2020. Out of abundance of caution and under directives from federal, state and county governments, the Board of Directors are currently working to evaluate operational services to determine needed changes to ensure everyone’s safety. The spread of COVID-19 is a public health issue; and the virus is causing great concern and we want you to know that we share that concern.

At this time, the **Apache Pool** is **closed**, and all scheduled classes, practices and events are cancelled until further notice. All **activities** at the **Jumano Community Center** and the **Walker House** have been **suspended** including on-site office hours.

The Board of Directors will **update** any **future operational changes** through various communications mediums including email, Facebook, Twitter and the web site (www.blockhousemud.com). Most of the District’s contractors and offices will serve the public and continue operations by using technology, phones, email, mail, and drop-boxes, as needed.

The Board of Directors is taking the situation very seriously and will closely monitor any and all developments. We will adjust our operations further as necessary and will keep you informed of any additional changes needed to protect our residents.
